



How to Estimate the Economic Costs of Violence?

Main approaches to estimating the costs of violence against women:

1 "Unit cost"

A step-by-step calculation of costs associated with a certain service package to be provided to a survivor in a certain case; the cost is multiplied by the number of survivors for a country-wide assessment




2 "Total operating costs"

Estimating the full volume of funding of services for survivors or interventions on preventing violence against women.



"Proportional operating costs"

Identifying a proportion of costs targeted at survivors of violence within the total scope of certain services financing.










Violence against Women Implies Economic Costs for Everyone

Violence-related economic losses not only burden the survivors, but also employers and taxpayers, insurance funds, budgets of various levels and the entire national economy







How Much Do We Pay when Somebody Abuses a Woman?



\$208 million per year

aggregate economic costs of violence against women to the society, which is comparable to the yearly budget of Odesa city (0.23 percent of the country's GDP in 2015)



How Much Does a Woman Pay for Her Suffering?



US dollars










How Much Does the Economy Lose due to Disability of Survivors?

lost economic output due to disability of women affected by violence








Costs of Services Provided in Response to Violence


