
Compared to 2020, the participation of fathers in caring for children of all age categories has significantly increased: in daily care 26%



The majority of parents know that the child's father has a legal right to take:

14 days paid leave when the child is born

of the child's mother

a leave to take care of children aged under 3 years old instead

number of men who expressed a similar desire for themselves also increased


