

ADDRESSING GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

- ◆ Since 20 April, 24 UNFPA-supported psychosocial support mobile teams (PSS MTs) operating in 12 regions of Ukraine; Zaporizhzhia, Dnipro, Poltava, Odesa, Vinnytsia, Uzhhorod, Ternopil, Chernivtsi, Khmelnytskyi, Lviv, Lutsk and Ivano-Frankivsk.
- ◆ 1000 female essentials packs are pre-positioned in Zaporizhzhia for distribution to women and girls, evacuated from Mariupol and occupied settlements of the Zaporizhzhia region.

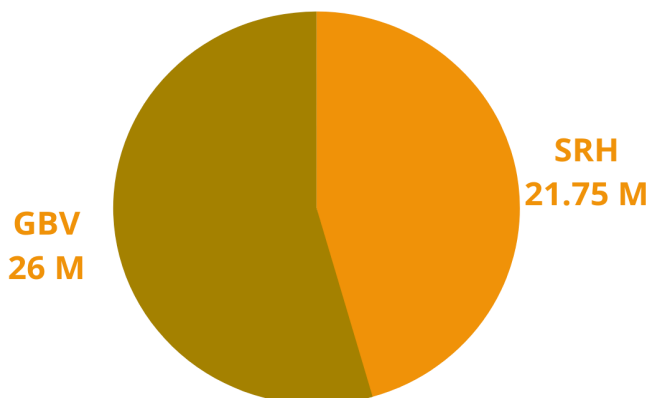
ENSURING SAFE BIRTH & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- ◆ UNFPA is dispatching one mobile maternity clinic to Chernihiv oblast, to provide much needed reproductive health services including safe delivery.
- ◆ To date, UNFPA delivered more than 40 metric tons of desperately needed reproductive health supplies, medicines and equipment to hospitals and mobile teams in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Dnipro and Zaporizhzhia.
- ◆ With our partner, Ukrainian Medical Mission is providing support to survivors of sexual and gender-based violence in the Northern parts of Kyiv region through health mobile teams. Services have included surgical repair with the use of the CMR kits and support has reached 22 survivors from Irpin and Bucha



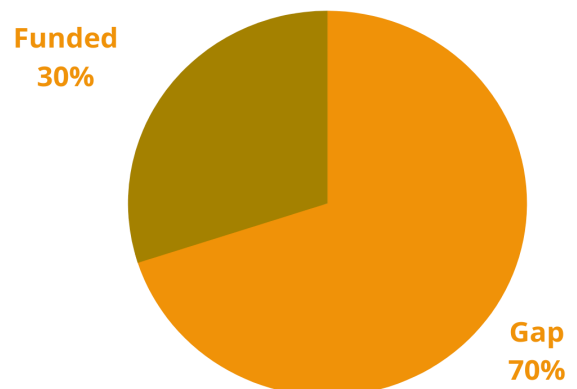
UNFPA UKRAINE FUNDING REQUEST
