


## ADDRESSING GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

- ◆ UNFPA is coordinating with **30 facilities for GBV survivors** including survivors of conflict-related sexual violence. UNFPA is delivering supplies, dignity kits and essential packs based on needs assessment to ensure women and girls have access to much-needed care.
- ◆ UNFPA-supported [Aurora, an online platform](#) recorded **ten cases of conflict-related sexual violence**. The platform provides providing specialised psychotherapy for survivors of gender-based violence, including conflict-related sexual violence and ensures that survivors have access to quality remote assistance inside and outside Ukraine.
- ◆ UNFPA is supporting the national toll-free hotline for gender-based violence survivors and the hotline for survivors operated by LaStrada NGO. The LaStrada hotline has received during the reporting period **1,442 calls and online requests for support, including 453 GBV cases out of which 79% were reported by women**. Since the start of the war, more than 9,520 people reached out to the LaStrada hotline seeking support.
- ◆ **TatoHub.Kramatorsk continues operating in the Donetsk region in the framework of the UN Recovery and Peacebuilding Programme supported by the EU**. Since the beginning of the war, the TatoHub launched the humanitarian association "Everything will be ok" in partnership with Donetsk regional and local authorities as well as local NGOs and volunteers and helped coordinate the evacuation of 290 000 people, the **majority of whom are women and girls, and including people with disabilities**, from the Donetsk region to the safe areas, coordinated the delivery of more than 3.5 tons of humanitarian aid, provided hundreds of thousands of crisis information consultations through hotlines, offline and online communication channels and offered more than 30,000 psychological consultations to the people from the Donetsk region.

## ENSURING SAFE BIRTH & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- ◆ **Three UNFPA-supported mobile teams** are operated by the Ukrainian Medical Mission (UMM), in cooperation with Regional Health Department in Kyiv, Vinnitsya and Lviv. Over the last two weeks, these mobile health teams provided **more than 940 women** with much-needed sexual and reproductive health services and referrals to specialised medical services, especially for severe cases that require immediate attention and treatment.
- ◆ Since the beginning of the crisis, UNFPA **delivered 73 MT (625 kits) of emergency reproductive health kits** to 33 perinatal centres, 4 health mobile teams and 1 mobile primary health clinic.

## INTER-AGENCY COORDINATION

### ◆ RH Working Group

UNFPA chairs the **SRH Working group** under the Health Cluster, ensuring the coordinated response of 52 partners including with respect to the distribution of reproductive health kits to health facilities.



### ◆ GBV Sub-cluster

Over 95 organisations are part of the **GBV Sub-cluster led by UNFPA** under the Protection Cluster to map services available in the country, identify gaps and needs, and coordinate the response with regular meetings to ensure a coordinated response .

- ⇒ Developed GBViE genetic referral pathway to assist specialists & non-GBV actors to refer survivors to specialised assistance. The referral pathway guidelines highlight the need to follow the survivor centered approach, define types of specialised services/assistance and list laws relevant for GBViE in Ukraine. In parallel, **with the support of the UNFPA, GBV services have been mapped in 13 regions available to the GBV SC partners for prompt response.**
- ⇒ **Developed the tool for the rapid assessment of the gaps and needs in service provision in Ukraine.** The Rapid assessment was launched calling GBV service provider organizations to contribute in identification of trends, needs and capacities for better coordination and planning;
- ⇒ **GBV risk assessment in cash programming**, jointly developed by the GBV SC/Cash WG **finalised and published** enabling cash actors to benefit from enhanced understanding of GBV risks and plan prevention and mitigation activities accordingly.

## UNFPA UKRAINE FUNDING STATUS (AS OF 19 JUNE)

- ◆ UNFPA requests **US\$ 47.75 million for life-saving reproductive health and gender-based violence interventions** to address the needs of women and girls in Ukraine affected by the war. Until 19 June, UNFPA Appeal was **77% funded**.
- ◆ Our appreciation for the support of **Denmark, the Republic of Korea, Canada, the United Kingdom, Sweden, Estonia, Spain, Norway, Iceland, Ireland, Australia, the EU (DG-ECHO, DG-NEAR), OCHA-Ukraine Humanitarian Fund, the UN Partnership to Promote the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNPRPD), and CERF**, for their contributions to the UNFPA humanitarian response appeal for Ukraine.
- ◆ UNFPA is grateful to our donors contributing to essential core resources and which enable programmes to be delivered in a predictable and sustainable manner.
